## Improved gateway to Ashford is now open!

MP Kwasi Kwarteng and Cllr Joanne Sexton lobbied South West Trains and Network Rail to enhance the appearance of our station and the surrounding area. Work has started which will provide an access ramp and tactile paving which will be completed by end March. Looking further ahead, we will be working alongside local businesses, Bronzefield Prison and other local volunteers on plans to improve the appearance of land around the station which in the past have tended to become overgrown and unsightly.

In addition Surrey County Council have resurfaced Station Approach.



## Community Champions

Community Champions from the Ashford North Residents Association (ANRA) are supporting this project and they are meeting South West Trains to ascertain what role they will play in the future up keep of the station. CLRs Gething and Sexton are being supported by Naz Islam, Sinead Mooney, Anne-Marie Neale and Olivia Rybinski

## Redevelopment of Brooklands College Site

The college site is in the process of being sold and it is likely to be redeveloped. We will keep you updated and we will do our utmost to defend the Protected Open Space behind the existing college site.

## Zone 6

We support Olivia Rybinski's online campaign to make Ashford a Zone 6 station. Having Oyster card available at the station would mean more flexible travel in and out of our town. Our MP Kwasi Kwarteng is liaising with Transport for London and South West Trains who may implement a Smart Card ticketing system or extend the Oyster Card zone. More news will follow as and when progress is made.
