A MESSAGE FROM KWASI KWARTENG MP



It is a great honour and privilege to have been re-elected as Member of Parliament for Spelthorne. The election turnout was 68.6 % compared to 67.1% in 2010. The Conservatives secured 24,386 votes - 50% of the vote. UKIP attained 10,234 votes, and Labour 9,114 votes.

I would like to thank everyone who took part in the election regardless of who they voted for. As the local MP, my job is to represent every local resident, irrespective of party politics, and I am determined to do this and defend the Borough's best interests in Parliament over the next five years.

This year, the general election coincided with the local borough elections, for the first time since 1982! The Conservatives won 35 of 39 available seats. Alison Griffiths was elected as your local councillor in Sunbury Common. She is a dynamic and forceful personality who comes very much from a different background from most local politicians.
